## History

- **May 1960:** Voters in the district approved the creation of East Harris County Union Junior College and a seven-member Board of Regents was established
- **February 1961:** Dr. Thomas Spencer was elected the first president of San Jacinto College
- **September 1961:** 876 students attended the College at its location in Pasadena
- **1975:** North campus opens for students
- **1978:** South campus opens for students
- **1999:** Voters in the District approve a \$91 million bond referendum, which included funds to construct the state-of-the-art Interactive Learning Centers (ILC) on each campus
- **May 2008:** Voters in the District approve a \$295 million bond referendum for construction of new allied health and science facilities, a one-stop-shop student success center, and renovations to libraries
